Unfortunately, many kids with paralysis and other physical challenges in our community *never have experienced the joy and adventure of a playground.* But with your help, Rochester Rotary will make this possible.

Rochester Rotary is building a **fully accessible playground** at the Sunshine Campus in Rush, N.Y., which gives children with special needs unique overnight camping experiences. **Shirley's Playland** will feature a slide, a glider, towers, climbers, a spinner, a sight and

sound panel, a sign language panel, gravity cube, chin-up bars, and much more.

The playground is being named for Shirley Isaac, wife of past Rochester Rotary President Jim Isaac. Shirley loved children and the Sunshine Camp immensely. There is no better tribute to her memory than a fun, accessible playground at the camp.

The project is expected to be completed in spring 2019, but Rochester Rotary needs your help to raise the funds needed for construction.
